 by Act. Sec. A.D. 1854 - To wit - Lots No. Eighty-Nine
 Rhode Island Street (89) - And I Wm. Cleland aforesaid
 my heirs executors administrators and assigns, are held
 and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Four
 Hundred Dollars, to said Jas. M. Hendry aforesaid his
 heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly
 make over and convey unto him or them all the title which

 or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever to any
