Sads of Lawrence aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claim'd and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Charles & Fads - And to his heirs and assigns forever all right title estate interests claims and demands in proportion or in expectancy of in or to the following described lands situated in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit - Lots Number Fifty Five (55) on Mapachusett Street Seventy Six (76) and Seventy Eight (78) on Annadale Street and Seventy Seven (77) on Ohio Street - To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Fads - And to his heirs and assigns forever - And we the said Woodward & Poyer for ourselves and our heirs executors and Administrators, do covenant with the said Fads his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by us that we have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same and that we shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Fads his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by himself or under his last assignee now other - And we the said Philip W Woodward & son f. Poyer our heirs and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Thousand Dollars to the said C. & F. Sads his heirs, executors and administrators make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be accorded or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the said Site of Lawrence aforesaid springing from the general lands office - In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this Twenty Fourth day of March A.D. 1857
