This indenture, made this First day of July A.D. 1855 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. W. Sycinos and Geo W Hutchinson Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence Kansas Territory parties of the first part and Samuel Kennedy & Samuel Frye under the name and firm of Kennedy & Frye parties of the second part witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the deed in trust from one William H. W. Sycinos to the above Sanatized creating said Trusts, And in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by said Kennedy & Frye of said Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have conveyed released and quit claimed and by these presents do convey release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Sittographes Chart as surveyed by A.D. and S. A.D. 1854 as follows, to wit - Vermont Street to Number Nine (9) to name and hold the aforesaid quit claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto
