 hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by
 these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said W^m
 Bentz & Co & Bentz and to their heirs and assigns forever all
 my right title estates interests, claims and demands in proportion
 or in effectancy of in and to the following described lands situ-
 ated in the Town of Fairview aforesaid, to wit - Lot Number
 Eighty Nine (89) on New York Street, To have and to hold
 the above described premises with the privileges and appur-
 tenances thereunto belonging, unto the said W^m Bentz and
 Co & Bentz their heirs and assigns forever - And I the
 said S. C. Harrington for myself and my heirs executors
 and administrators, do covenant with the said W^m Bentz
 & Co & Bentz their heirs and assigns, that the said prem-
 ies are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by
 me that I have full right and power to sell convey
 and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant
 and defend the same unto the said W^m Bentz & Co & Bentz
 their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful
 claims and demands of all persons claiming by virtue
 or under me but against none other - And I the said
 S. C. Harrington my heirs and assigns, are well and firmly
 bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars
 to the said W^m Bentz & Co & Bentz their heirs, executors
 and administrators to make and convey unto them all
 further right or title which shall or may be awarded or
 conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or
 persons by virtue of a title to the same set up or pur-
 sued against me from the general Land office - In witness
