Eight Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Louis Meintzer of Missouri
Illinois the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and
quit claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto
the said Louis Meintzer and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right
title, estate, interest claim and demands in possession or in expectation
of, in and to the following described land, situated in the Town of Lawrence
aforesaid, to wit: Lot Number One Hundred and Two (102) on Vermont Street
with the house thereon - To have and to hold the above described premises
with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the
said Louis Meintzer his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said
Jacob Bollman for myself and my heirs executors and administrators
do covenant with the said premises are free from all encumbrances
made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell
convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant
and defend the same unto the said Meintzer his heirs and assigns
forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
claiming by through or under me but against none other. And
I the said Jacob Bollman my heirs and assigns are held
and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Thousand
Dollars to the said Meintzer his heirs executors and administrators
to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which
shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by
law
