Two Hundred Twenty Three (223) in Mississippi Sub. One Hundred Twenty Five (175) in Mississippi, That And Two Hundred Twenty (220) in Indiana That To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Vails his heirs and assigns forever And I the said George Gilbert for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Ed Vails his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from
