State and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right, title, estate interest, claim and demands in possession or in expectation of, in and to the following described lands situated in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid to wit Lot Number one Hundred Seventy Eight (178) on New York Street

To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Geo M. State his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Jane S. Burditt for myself and my heirs executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Geo M. State his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by one that I have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Geo M. State his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other. And I the said Jane S. Burditt my heirs and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars to the said Geo M. State his heirs executors and administrators to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the said lots of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general land office.
