And I the said William Hare for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Joseph Harris his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant & defend the same unto the said Harris his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other. And I the said William Hare my heirs and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One hundred Dollars to the said Harris his heirs executors and administrators to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the Town Site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general land office
