of the sum of Thirty Dollars to me in hand paid by John Spear
of said Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents
do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said John Spear
his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever all
my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following
described land situated and lying in the City of Lawrence in
the County of Kansas, to wit: Lot Number Sixty Four (64)
on Pennsylvania Street according to survey and plan made
by Addison Oct. 20th 1854 - And I the said Susan Papett
my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and
fully bound by these presents in the sum Sixty Dollars to the
said John Spear his heirs executors administrators and assigns
to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and
valid title such as the said Susan Papett shall receive from
the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above
described property. To have and to hold the same with all
the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
