

This Indenture Made this Twenty day of February AD 1857 between James S Snyder and Erver John P. Wood William H. Sykins and George W. Hutchinson  
 Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence Kansas Territory, parties of the first  
 part and John Story party of the second part witnesseth that in compliance  
 with the provisions contained in the deed in trust from one William H. R.  
 Sykins to the above Trustees creating said trustee and in consideration  
 of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by said John Story of  
 said town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
 covenanted released and quit claimed and by these presents do convey  
 release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs  
 and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots of  
 land situated and being in Lawrence first named Street Ham  
 Territory and designated on the Telegraphic chart as surveyed by  
 A.D. Lewis October AD 1854 as follows To wit lot Number Sixty  
 Six (66) Kentucky Street to have and to hold the premises quic  
 claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging unto the said party of the second part  
 so that neither the said Trustees nor heir or assigns or  
 any person claiming by them or under them or them shall have  
 any right title interest claim or demand in or to the aforesaid  
 premises or any part thereof, and we hereby covenant and  
 agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming  
 any right title or interest under the said Trustees their heirs or  
 successors And further this Indenture witnesseth that the said  
 Samuel S Snyder and Erver John P. Wood William H. R. Sykins  
 and George W. Hutchinson and their successors are held and firmly  
 bound unto the said John Story in the sum of Two Thousand  
 Dollars to be paid unto the said John Story his heirs or assigns  
 to which payment will and truly to be made we bind our  
 selves and our executors by these presents - Now the condition  
 of this obligation is such that if upon the payment by  
 the said party of the second part of all taxes lawfully  
 exacted upon the aforesaid premises the said parties  
 of the first part or their successors shall make and  
 deliver unto the said party of the second part his heirs  
 or assigns a good and valid deed with the usual  
 covenants for conveyance in fee simple whenever a
