Know all Men by these presents That I William Shaw of the Town of Laurence County of Otsego for and in Consideration of the sum of Eighteen Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of the above mentioned place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargain sold and quit claiming and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Henry Campbell his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demands in and to the following described lands situate and lying in the Town of Laurence in the County of Otsego according to the survey made by Asa Shaw A.D. 1854. To wit - Lot No Twenty Two (22) Connecticut Street - And I William Shaw aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Fifty Dollars to Henry Campbell aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Laurence a firm any power or person whatsoever to any and all of the above described property.
