And that such executors are held and firmly bound unto the said John Mack in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to be paid unto the said John Mack his heirs or assigns, to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our executors by these presents - That the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the payment by the second party of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises the said parties of the first part, or their executors shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second part his heirs or assigns a good and valid deed with the usual covenants for conveyance in few simple words a patent for the same site of Lawrence shall issue from Congress unto me Robert Robttnson or William H. R. Lykins and he conveys unto the aforesaid trustees then this obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force.

Archibalds of said town and delivery there receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have conveyed released and quit claimed and by these presents do convey release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being over
