sell to the said <sup>Wm</sup> Woods or assigns all my right title and  
interest by and to any lot or lots in the City of Lawrence  
being one city interest in said City received as a member  
of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Party from the East being One - One fourth  
and ~~one~~<sup>one</sup> eighth & ~~one~~<sup>one</sup> ninth part of said City under the old arran-  
gement and ~~one~~<sup>one</sup> twentieth part of said city under the new arran-  
gement except the first lot drawn to my name already  
sold to the said Woods and including all lots that have  
or may hereafter be drawn to my name as a member  
of the said 2<sup>nd</sup> party and member of the Lawrence associa-
