 Dollars, to me in hand paid by James Garvin & Thomas J. Garvin of the
 same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained,
 sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and
 quit claim unto the said James Thomas Garvin their heirs executors
 administrators and assigns forever all my right, title interest
 claim and demands in and to the following described lands
 situated and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas
 according to the survey made by Andrew Lewis and 1854, to wit - Lot
 Numbering Thirty Six (36) Mapa classis Sixth in said Town
 And of the said John P. Wood affirms my said executors administrators
 and assigns are duly and firmly bound by these presents in
 the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to said James & T. J. Garvin
 affording them heirs executors administrators and assigns to well
 and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title
 which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawren-
 ce or from any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and
 all of the above described property, to have and to hold the
 same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto
 belonging forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
