I This all men by these presents, That I Samuel G. Howe of Boston  
 in the County of Suffolk in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Doctor  
 of Medicine have constituted, ordained and made and in my stead and  
 place forth and by these presents do constitute, ordain and make and in my  
 stead and place for Edmund T. Whitman of Lawrence in the County  
 of Essex to be my true sufficient and lawful attorney for me and  
 in my name and stead to manage and direct, and to sell and convey  
 any and all real estate and any and all my rights to the same in  
 the Territory of Kansas which I now hold or may hereafter hold by  
 virtue of an appointment to me & January 1857 by said Whit-  
 man of a bond for conveyance of one enclosed seventh part of a  
 section of land adjoining the town of Lawrence. Made to him by  
 me Walker 22 June 1855 - 2<sup>nd</sup> of a Wyandot Fleet of our slaves for  
 me and in my name by said Whitman \$5. By virtue of any pur-  
 chase of lands in Kansas Territory or rights thereto, in my name  
 and for me, by said Whitman as my agent under the terms of  
 our agreement between said Whitman and myself dated Nov.  
 1856 all parts of the above to be in such lots and parcels and  
 for such prices, and on such terms of payment as we shall judge  
 best, and to make execute acknowledge and deliver any and all  
 instruments necessary to make such conveyance effectual in law  
 but without any warranty of title and without any covenants except that  
 the greater and interest aforesaid are clear of encumbrances by me made

And we said Samuel G. Howe and Sulia wife of said Samuel G. Howe  
 also constitute and appoint said Whitman the attorney of said Sulia  
 for her and her name to unite in any conveyance aforesaid, and  
 convey and release all right of dower or other right which said  
 Sulia may by law have in any and all real estate above mentioned  
 and to all things necessary to convey this power into full effect -
