

This Indenture made this Tenth day of March A.D. 1857 between Samuel J. Sawyer Esq
 Esq John P. Wood William H.B. Sykes and Geo Hutchinson Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence
 Kansas Parties of the First part and Heinen Green and Aaron J. Pottor parties of the second
 part. Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the deed in Trust from one
 William H.B. Sykes to the above Trustees creating said Trustee and in consideration of the sum
 of One Dollar in hand paid by Heinen Green & Aaron J. Pottor of said Town and District the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quit claims and by
 these presents do convey release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part
 his heirs and assigns all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated
 and being in Lawrence First Concess Plat, Kansas District, and designated on the Litteral
 Chart as surveyed by Andrew October A.D. 1854 - as follows All that lot or Block
 bounded on the East by Delaware Street and on the West by Pennsylvania Street and
 on the South by Main Street and on the North by Washington Street Containing
 Two (2) acres more or less provided the above named Heinen Green and Aaron
 J. Pottor shall continue to make and own brick on the above granted lot
 of Land and shall not make use of said land for any other purposes or sell
 to any one who will not comply with the above conditions - So henceforth to hold
 the aforesaid quit claims premises with all the franchises and appurtenances thereto
 belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither we said Trustees nor
 heirs or successors or any person claiming by, from or under us or them, shall have
 any right, title interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any
 part thereof and we hereby warrant and agree to warrant and defend against
 all persons claiming any right, title or interest under the said Trustees their heirs
 or successors. And further this indenture witnesseth that the said Samuel J. Sawyer
 Esq Esq John P. Wood William H.B. Sykes and Geo Hutchinson and their successors
 are held and firmly bound unto the said Green & Pottor in the sum of Two Thousand
 Dollars to be paid unto the said Green and Pottor their heirs or assigns to which
 payment we and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our successors by
 these presents - Now the condition of this obligation is as follows if upon the payment
 by the said parties of the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid
 premises the said parties of the first part or their successors shall make or add
 on unto the aforesaid party of the second part his heirs or assigns a good and valuable
 with the usual covenants for conveyance in full simple whenever a demand for the
 sum due of Lawrence shall arise from any one unto one Robert Bobbitt or
 William H.B. Sykes and be conveyed unto the aforesaid Trustees then this obligation
 shall be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force
