sell any quit claim, unto the said I. W. Cliff and to his heirs and assigns
forever, all my right, title, estate, interest, claim and demand,
either or in expectancy of, in and to the following described land
located in the town of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit: Lot No. One Hundred
Thirty Five (135) A. S. It is to have and to hold the above de-
scribed premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
ing, unto the said I. W. Cliff heirs and assigns forever. That I, the
said S. B. Prentiss for myself and my heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns with the said Cliff his heirs and assigns, trust the said lands
are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that
have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same
