 heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances now
 or suffered by me, that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit-
 claim the same and that I shall and will warrant ~~and~~ defend the same
 unto the said Davis Kelley Jr his heirs and assigns forever against all
 lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me
 but against none other. And I the said Ed Ladd my heirs and assigns are
 held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Four Hundred Dollars
 to the said Davis Kelley Jr his heirs executors and administrators to make and
 convey unto him or them also further right or title which shall or may be
 awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons by
 virtue of a title by the Court of Probate of Lawrence aforesaid if duly from the general
