ation of the sum of Two Hundred & Eight Dollars to me in hand paid
by J. N. Wood & Co of Lawrenceburg the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged I now bargained sold and quit claim and by these presents do bar-
gain sell and quit claim unto the said J. N. Wood & Co and to his heirs
and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demand
in property or in expectancy of in and to the following described land
situated in the Town of Lawrenceburg to wit Lot number sixty
Two (62) Ohio street - I have and to hold the above described premises
with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said J.
N. Wood & Co their heirs and assigns forever And I the said Edward
Sutton Smith for myself and my heirs executors and administrators
do covenant with the said J. N. Wood & Co their heirs and assigns that
the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by
me that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim
the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the
same unto the said J. N. Wood & Co their heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming
by himself or under me but against none other And I the
said Edward Sutton Smith my heirs and assigns are held and
firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five Hundred
Dollars to the said J. N. Wood & Co their heirs executors and
administrators to make and convey unto them all further
right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to
me by any authority or by any persons by virtue of a bill
to the Town Site of Lawrenceburg sprung from the general
Land Office In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
