

This indenture, made this Second day of June A.D. 1835 between
 Samuel S. Snyder and Grover John P. Wood William H. C. Lykins and George
 W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Sonn Site of Laurence Stansee Cemetery
 parties of the first part and Samuel N. Wood party of the second part,
 witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the deed
 in Trust from one William H. C. Lykins to the above Trustees creating
 said Cemetery in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand
 paid by said Samuel N. Wood of said Town and County, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed released and quit claimed
 and by these presents do convey release and quit claim unto the said
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right title and inter-
 est in and to certain lots of land situated and lying in Laurence First
 Congregationalist Cemetery Stansee Cemetery and designated on the lithographed chart
 or surveying by A. D. Lewis October 1st 1854 as follows Share number eighty
 eight (88) containing the following lots viz Ohio street sixty six (66)
 Kentucky street one hundred fifty four (154) New Hampshire Street one
 hundred four (104) Indiana street three hundred twenty two (322)
 Ohio street Ninety nine (99) New Jersey Street ninety five (95) and
 one hundred sixteen (116) Vermont Street one hundred eighty five
 (185) Mississippi Street two hundred seventy seven (277) and two
 hundred seventy nine (279) New Jersey Street one hundred fifty
 seven (157) And lot Vermont Street forty four (44) so have and
 to hold the premises ^{quit claim} with all the priviledges and appurtenances
 belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither
 we said Trustees our heirs or executors or any person claiming by or from or
 under us or them shall have any right title interest claim or demands
 in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof and we hereby covenant
 and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any right
 title or interest under the said Trustees their heirs or executors ^{and fur-}
 ther this indenture witnesseth that the said Samuel S. Snyder does deliver
 John P. Wood William H. C. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson and their successors
 an bill and firmly binds unto the said Samuel N. Wood in the sum of Two
 Thousand Dollars to be paid unto the said Wood his heirs or assigns to which
 payment will and truly to be made at his own orders and executors by these
 presents Now the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the payment
 by the said party of the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the afo-
 said premises the said parties of the first part or their successors shall make
