Thirty Eight (138) on Rockwood Islands Street. To have ~~and~~ to hold  
the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging unto the said Seagarden ~~and~~ Seples their heirs and  
assigns forever. And I the said Woolen for myself and my heirs  
executors and administrators do covenant with the said Seagarden  
& Seples their heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from  
all encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and  
power to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and  
will warrant & defend the same unto the said Grantees their heirs  
and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all  
persons claiming by, through or under me but against none other.  
And I the said Robert S. Woolen my heirs and assigns are here and  
firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars
