In consideration of Two Hundred Dollars to me paid by George W Collamore I hereby transfer set over and assigns unto him and his assigns the above agreement together with all the rights and privileges therein set forth said Collamore paying to said Ingersoll or his legal representatives the further sum of Two Thousand Dollars in Two Years from the date hereof in semi-annual instalments of Five Hundred Dollars each with interest at the rate of Ten per cent per annum. And I do also hereby release unto said Collamore and his legal representatives the right, title and interest which I have in and to the premises therein described - I also hereby agree to save harmless and fully indemnify said Collamore and his legal representatives as to the right, title and interest which I have in and to the premises therein

described. I also from the payments of One Thousand Dollars on thirty days from the date of the foregoing agreement with Note as therein mentioned the payments as described in this agreement being to be made in lieu thereof by said Collamore do that amount, and said Collamore agreeing to pay One Thousand Dollars to said Note as part of the said sum of Two Thousands by the first two instalments herein mentioned and the additional thousands Dollars to said Ingersoll and his legal representatives by the last two instalments herein mentioned In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hands and seals this seventh day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty Seven
