Association of Boston Massachusetts the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents
do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said American Mutineer
Association their heirs executors administrators, and assigns, forever all
my right, title interest claim and demand in and to the following
described lands situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in
the Territory of Kansas to wit - Lot number one hundred and
Twenty seven on Ohio Street according to the survey made by G. S.
Seers in October 1854 And I the said John Spear my heirs execu-
tors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by
these presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the said
American Mutineer Association their heirs executors administrators and
assigns to well and lawfully make over and convey unto said Association
a good and valid title such as the said John Spear shall receive from
the Trustees of the City of Lawrence or any other person or power to any
and all of the above described property To have and to hold the same
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever
