Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Erver, John P. Wm. William W.C. Sykins and
George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Townsite of Lawrence Kansas
Party of the first part and Elmore Allen party of
the second part witness that in compliance with the provision
contained in the deed in trust from Mr. William W.C. Sykins
to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of
the sum of one Dollar in hand paid by Elmore Allen of said
sum and testimony the receipt whereof we hereby acknowledge have
conveyed released and quit claims and by these presents do convey
release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his
heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots
of land situated and being in Lawrence First Concess Sectional Plan
Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographie Chart as surveyed
by Andrew October A.D. 1854 as follows So with Lot Thirteen (13) Con-
nected therewith to have and to hold the aforesaid quit claims
premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
unto the said party of the second part so that neither we nor our heirs
nor successors or any person claiming by from or under us
or them shall have any right title interest claim or demands in or
to the following premises or any part thereof and we hereby covenant
and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any
right title or interest under the said Trustees their heirs or successors
over
