 and our successers by these presents. Now the condition of this obligation
 is such, that if upon the aforesaid premises, the said parties of the first
 part or their successers shall make and deliver unto the said party of
 the second part, his heirs or assigns a good and valid deed, with the
 usual covenants for conveyance in fee simple whereever a patent for the
 Town Site of Lawrence shall issue from Congress unto one Robert Robb and
 or William W. R. Eskins and be conveyed unto the aforesaid Trustees then
 this obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in
 full force In testimony whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and
 seals this 7 day of July A.D. 1855.
