 One Thousand Dollars, to me in hand paid by C. A. Wright of Lawrence
 Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold
 and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim
 unto the said C. A. Wright his heirs executors administrators and assigns
 forever all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the follow-
 ing described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the State
 of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Sears A.D. 1854 & with
 Lot 11 Map 1st Vol 1st Map sheet Also 2d Vermont Street And
 James C. Bishop assigns his heirs executors administrators and
 assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of
 One Thousand Dollars to said C. A. Wright of said his heirs
 executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and
 convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive from
 the Trusts of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any prior or present
 or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described prop-
 erty So have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appur-
 tenances thereunto belonging forever In witness whereof have here-
 unto set my hand and seal this Fifteenth Day of January A.D.
