forever all my right title interest claim and demands in and to the follow-  
ing described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the State  
of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. N. Lewis A.D. 1854 vizt  
Lot 11 Map 1st Vol 65 Map 1st lot Also 20 Vermont Street And  
James S. Bishop affirms his heirs executors administrators and  
assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of  
One Thousand Dollars to said C. A. Wright against his heirs  
executors administrators any assigns to well and truly make over and  
convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive from  
the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person  
or persons whomever to any and all of the above described prop-  
erty To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and ap-  
plications thereto belonging forever In witness whereof have here-  
unto set my hand and seal this Fifteenth Day of January A.D.  
1857 signed sealed and delivered in presence Jas S. Bishop sole heir to  
of Abner Johnson the Estate of Wm S. Bishop deceased
