ufell Street Together with all and singular the privileges and appur-
tenances therunto belonging. And also all the right title on-
tress and claim whatsoever as well in law as in equity of the said
Maurice Hartmann of or to the above described premises And the said
Maurice Hartmann for his heirs executors administrators and assigns
does covenant and agree to and with the said Edward Sutton Smith his
heirs executors administrators and assigns that he has not made nor
or suffers any act or thing whereby the above described premises or
any part thereof now are or at any time hereafter shall be conveyed
quit claimed. or encumbered in any manner whatsoever And
be it further known by these presents. That I the said Maurice
Hartmann am held and firmly bound unto the said Edward Sutton
Smith his heirs and assigns in the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars
to be paid unto the said Edward Sutton Smith his heirs or assigns
in the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to be paid unto the said Edward
Sutton Smith his heirs or assigns to which payment will and
truly to be made I bind myself my heirs executors administrators
and assigns by these presents Now the condition of this obligation
is such that if the said Maurice Hartmann his heirs or
assigns shall convey unto the said Edward Sutton Smith his
heirs or assigns whatever further title may or shall be unto the said
Maurice Hartmann conveyed by the trustees of the Town Site
of Cauenoe said Territory or by or from any person or persons
whomsoever or by any power whatsoever by virtue of a Patent of-
ficing from the Land Office at Washington unto one William H.R.
Clymus or one Robert Robttsale. a Wyandott Indian. or by virtue of
E. Bladet Reg
