This Indenture made this second day of June AD 1855 Between James S.
Snyder late Gover. John P. Mrs. William H. R. Deykins and George W. Hutchison
Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas, Reming party of the first part
and James R. White party of the second part Witnesseth, that in compliance
with the provisions contained in the deed in trust from one William H. R.
Deykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar in hand paid by said James R. White of said Town and
Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed to him
and quit claims and by these presents do convey, all and quit claim
unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title
and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Kansas
First Ward District Kansas Territory, and designated on the following
his Chart as surveyed by A. G. Davis, October A.D. 1854, as follows to wit

Lot number Twenty Two Rhode Island Street to have and to
the aforesaid quit claims of premises with all the privileges and appurten-
ances therunto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that
neither we, said Trustees our heirs or executors, or any person claiming
by, from or under us or them shall have any right title interest claim
or demands in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof and we hereby
covenant and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any
right title or interest under the said Trustees their heirs or executors and
further this Indenture Witnesseth, that the said James S. Snyder late
Gover. John P. Mrs. William H. R. Deykins and George W. Hutchison and
their executors and heirs and jointly binds unto the said James R.
White in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to be paid unto the said
James R. White his heirs & assigns to which payment will monthly
be made we being ourselves and our executors by these presents now
the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the payment
by the said party of the second part of all dues lawfully assessed
