Deed of the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have conveyed released and quit claimed and by these do convey release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed chart as surveyed by A.D. Gear October 24th 1854. as follows: Lot No. 50 number nineteen (19) Connecticut Block or have and to hold the aforesaid quit claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we said Trustees our heirs or successors or any persons claiming by them or under us or them shall have any right title interest claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof; and we hereby command and enjoin to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any right title or interest under the said Trustees their heirs & successors. And further this indenture witnesseth that the said Samuel C. Snyder Joel Erver John P. Wood William H. R. Sykins and George W. Hutchinson and their successors are held and firmly bound unto the said Robert Banks in the sum of Two thousand dollars to be paid unto the said Robert Banks his heirs or assigns to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our successors by these presents. Know the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the payment by the said party of the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises, the said parties of the first part or their successors, shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second part his heirs & assigns a good and valid deed with the usual covenants for conveyance in fee simple whenever a patent from the Iron Side of Lawrence shall issue from Congress unto me Robert Robb Haile or William H. R. Sykins unto be conveyed unto the aforesaid Trustees then this obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force & witness of which we have hereunto set
