administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
by these Presents in the sum of Twenty five hundred
Dollars to the said Turner Sampson & C. Brackett
aforesaid their heirs executors administrators and
assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto
him or them all the title which he shall receive from
the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from
any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and
all of the described property to have and to hold
the same with all the privileges and appurtenances
