This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1805

 the provisions contained in the Deed of Trust from one William
 H. R. Skinner to the above Trustees ^{creators and trustees} in consideration of the
 sum one Dollar to be in hand paid by said Henry Smith of
 said Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged have conveyed released and quit claimed and by these
 Presents do convey release and quit claim unto the said
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all my
 right title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated
 and lying in Lawrence First Council District Kansas
 Territory and designated in the Lithographed Chart as
 surveyed by C. D. Seal October A.D. 1804 as follows
