 from any person or persons whomsoever, or by any
 power whatsoever by virtue of a Patent issuing from
 the Land Office at Washington unto one William
 H. R. Perkins or one Robert Rottshille a Wyandott
 Indian or by virtue of any other authority at
 such time as said title shall be to him conveyed
 then this obligation shall be wholly void and of no
 Effect, otherwise to remain in full force. In testi-
