 as of this day and in consideration of the sum of Three  
 Hundred and Twenty five Dollars to me in hand  
 paid by David T Bishop of West Chester Chester Co  
 Pennsylvania the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents  
 do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said  
 David T Bishop and to his heirs and assigns forever  
 all my rights title estate interest claim and demand  
 in possession or in expectancy of in and to the following  
 described land situate in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid  
 to wit Lot Number Thirty four (34) Rhode Island lot  
 containing half the above described premises with the  
 privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the  
 said David T Bishop his heirs and assigns forever. And I the  
 said Otis Potted for myself and my heirs executors and  
 administrators by covenant with the said David T Bishop  
 his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from  
 all encumbrances made or suffered by me, that I have  
 full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the  
 same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the  
 same unto the said David T Bishop his heirs and assigns  
 forever against the lawful claims and demands of all  
 persons claiming by through or under me but against  
 none others. And I the said Otis Potted my heirs and  
 assigns are fully and firmly bound by these presents  
 in the sum of Six hundred and fifty Dollars to the  
 said David T Bishop his heirs executors and administrators  
 to make and convey unto him or them all further  
 rights of title which shall or may be awarded or  
 conveyed by me by any authority, or by any person  
 or persons by virtue of a Title to the Town site of  
 Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general Land
