title, interest, claim, or demand in to the aforesaid  
premises or any part thereof; and we hereby covenant  
and agree to warrant and defend against all persons  
claiming any right title of interest under the said Trust-  
ees this day of successions. And further this Indenture  
Witnesseth that the said Samuel S. Smydes, Jas. Griggs  
John P. Wood William H. R. Lykins and Geo W. Hutchinson  
and their successors are held and firmly bound unto  
the said Henry D. Graves in the sum of two thousand  
Dollars to be paid unto the said Henry D. Graves his  
heirs or assigns to which payment well and truly to be made  
we bind ourselves and our ~~heirs~~ successors by these  
present. Now the condition of this obligation is such  
that if upon the payment by the said party of the second  
part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid  
premises the said parties of the first part to this succession  
shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second  
part this day of assigns a good and valid Deed with  
the usual covenants of conveyance in due simple  
whereof a patent for the Townsite of Lawrence  
shall issue from Congress unto me Robert Robitaille &  
William H. R. Lykins and be conveyed unto the aforesaid  
Trustees then this obligation shall be void and of no  
Effect otherwise to remain in full force. In testimony
