of the Town of Lawrence State of Kansas doth make and in consideration of the  
sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by D B James  
Leiby of Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents doth bargain  
sell and quit claim unto the said D B James Leiby his heirs executors  
administrators and assigns forever all right title interest claim and  
demands in and to the following described land in the state of  
Kansas to wit - three acres of land lying South East part in  
quarter of the float laid by Joel Walker of Wyandott known  
now as the part of quarter of said float in which said Mallory  
now lives when said float shall be laid into lots as contemplated  
by said Joel Walker and Ianson H Mallory aforesaid his heirs  
executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by  
these presents in the sum of Three hundred Dollars to said D B.  
James Leiby aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and  
assigns and truly make over and convey unto him or them and  
to warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims  
of all persons & person whomsoever to any and all of the  
above described property I do have and to hold the same with all the  
privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever. In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 4<sup>th</sup> day  
of December A.D. 1806.

An Article of Agreement Entering into this the 4<sup>th</sup> Day  
of December 1806. by and between M A. H. Mallory and  
D B James Leiby when said D B Leiby having purch-  
ased three acres of land lying in the East quarter of the float laid  
by Joel Walker in which said Mallory now lives he said  
Leiby agrees to divide said land in lots as contemplated  
by said Walker but should said Leiby divide the lot in which  
said Mallory stands he agrees to change it for another lot of  
equal value, and said Mallory hereby agrees that in case said  
Leiby shall divide his lots separate from each other and said  
lots
