

Know all men by these Presents That I O. E. Learnard
 of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas doth and in considera-
 tion of the sum of seven Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid
 by Baker Guest the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 bargained sold and quitclaimed and by these presents do bargain
 sell and quit claim unto the said Baker Guest and to his heirs and
 assigns forever all my right title estate interest claim and demand
 in possession of, in expectancy of in and to the following described
 land situated in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid to wit - an
 undivided half interest in Lot number forty nine (49.) in
 Massachusetts street - To have and to hold the above described
 premises with the privilege and appurtenances thereunto belonging
 unto the said Baker Guest his heirs and assigns forever, and
 I the said O. E. Learnard do myself and my heirs execu-
 tors and administrators do covenant with the said Baker Guest
 his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from
 all encumbrances made or suffered by me, that I have full
 right and power to convey and quit claim the same and that
 I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said
 Baker Guest his heirs and assigns forever, against the
 lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through
 or under me but against none others - and I the said O. E. Learnard
 my heirs executors administrators am fully bound
 by these presents in the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars
 to the said Baker Guest his heirs and assigns to make and
 convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall
 or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority
 or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the town
 site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general Land
 office - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
