



Know all men by these presents That

 to me in hand paid by Samuel Thompson of

 New York the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed  
 and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim  
 unto the said Samuel Thompson and to his heirs  
 executors administrators and assigns forever all  
 right title interest claim and demand in and  
 to the following described land situated and lying  
 in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas  
 to wit: Being an undivided tract  $\frac{1}{4}$  of part of lot  
 20 in the Section as designated on a map and  
 survey made by C. D. Beard et al. 1857. to which  
 map reference is had in making this conveyance  
 And I the said James C. Norton for myself and  
 my heirs executors administrators and assigns  
 do deed and quit claim by these presents in  
 the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to the  
 said Samuel Thompson his heirs executors  
 administrators and assigns to well and truly  
 make over and convey unto him or them a  
 good and valid title such as the said Norton shall  
 receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence  
 to any and all of the above described property  
 To have and to hold the same with all the  
 privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging  
 forever. I witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this Eighth day of  
 July et al. 1857.
