 our right title interest claim and demand in and to the
 following described land situate and lying in the City of
 Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, Louis - Being one
 undivided one third of Lots No. Eighty three & 3, eighty five
 (85) and eighty seven (87) L. C. street with the mill
 and all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging
 and we the said G. H. Snyder and T. D. Wakefield heirs
 executors administrators and assigns are held and
 firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Eight
 Hundred and twenty six Dollars to the said Nicholas
 Snyder heirs executors administrators and assigns to
 well and truly make over and convey unto him or them
 a good and valid title such as the said Snyder & Wakefield
 shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to
