 of the sum of Five Hundred and fifty Dollars  
 to me in hand paid by John E. Sutton of the  
 same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
 edged have bargained sold and quit claimed and  
 by these do bargain sell and quit claim unto the  
 said John E. Sutton and to his heirs and assigns  
 forever all my right title Estate interest claim  
 and demand, in possession or in expectancy of  
 in and to the following described land, situate in  
 the Town of Lawrence aforesaid. Town Lot number  
 Seventy five (75.) Rhode Island Street To have  
 and to hold the above described premises with the  
 privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, unto  
 the said John E. Sutton his heirs and assigns  
 forever. And I the said Samuel Wood for myself  
 and my heirs executors and administrators, do  
 covenant with the said John E. Sutton his heirs  
 and assigns. That the said premises are free from  
 all incumbrances made & suffered by me, that I  
 have full right and power to sell convey and quit  
 claim unto him and that I shall and will warrant  
 and defend the same unto the said John E. Sutton  
 his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful  
 claims and demands of all persons, claiming by  
 through & under me but against none other -  
 And I the said Samuel Wood my heirs executors  
 and administrators are fully bound by  
 these presents in the sum of One Thousand Dollars  
 to the said John E. Sutton his heirs and  
 assigns to make and convey unto him & them  
 all further right title which shall or may be  
 awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by  
 any person or persons, by virtue of a bill to the town  
 site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general
