the said Penoyed his heirs executors administrators and
assigns forever all my right title interest claim and
demands in and to the following described land situate
and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of
Kansas according to the survey made by C. D. Searl
A.D. 1804. Tract Lot No. seventy two (72) Delaware
Stre^t. and James & Emery abovesaid his heirs executors
administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars
to said Penoyed aforesaid his heirs executors administrators
and assigns to well and truly make over and convey
unto him & them all the title which he shall receive
from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from
any power or persons & persons whomsoever to any and
to all of the above described property to have and to
hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenance
