these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto
the said Perry and to his heirs and assigns forever all
my right title, Estate, interest, claim and demand, in
proposition & in effectancy of, in and to the following
described land situated in the town of Lawrence aforesaid
to wit: One undivided one half (½) of lot number
Thirty nine (39) on Hemm's Street. To have and
to hold the above described premises with the
privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging
unto the said Perry his heirs and assigns forever
and I the said Samuel Try for myself and my heirs executors
and administrators do covenant with the said Perry
his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are
free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me
that I have full right and power to sell convey
and quit claim the same and that I shall and
will WARRANT AND DEFEND the same unto the said
Perry his heirs and assigns forever against the
lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming
by, through or under me but against none other
and I the said Lawrence Samuel Try my heirs
executors and administrators are held and firmly bound
by these presents in the sum One thousand Dollars
