D. Beal A.D. 1854, to wit Lot Number Twenty nine (29) in Delaware Street. And I Samuel Fry aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to Sidney Orme his heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power of persons persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
