

This Indenture Made this eighteenth day of May A. D. 1859, between James S. Emery & Mary R his wife of Douglas County Kansas, of the first part, and Edward D. Thompson of same place of the second part. Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred & forty three $\frac{98}{100}$ dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give, grant, bargain, sell, release, convey and confirm unto to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described land, situated in Lawrence Douglas County aforesaid in Kansas Territory,

to wit, Lot number forty four (44) on Vermont Street & No three New Hampshire Street together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurte-

nances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, both in law and equity.

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred & forty three $\frac{98}{100}$ dollars in six months from the date hereof with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum until maturity & after ma-
turity if not paid to draw interest at the rate of three percent per month until
paid according to the condition of a certain promissory note this day executed and de-
livered by the said James S. Emery to the said party of the second part, and this con-
veyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default
be made in payment or any part thereof, as above provided, then it shall be lawful
for the said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in
the manner prescribed by law; and out of all money arising from such sale
to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with costs
and charges of making such sale and the attorney's fees for foreclosures and
thereof overplus if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such
sale, on demand, to the said James S. Emery & Mary R his wife their
