

Know all men by these presents, That I William Stevenson of the city of Lawrence,  
 Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty  
 dollars, to me in hand paid by James Roberts of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell  
 and quit claim unto the said Roberts and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right  
 title estate interest, claim and demand in possession or expectancy of, in and  
 to the following described land situated in the city of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit,  
 Lot number thirty four (34) Rhode Island Street, to have and to hold  
 the above described premises with the privilege and appurtenance thereunto belonging  
 unto the said Roberts his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said William Ste-  
 venson for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant  
 with the said Roberts his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from  
 all encumbrances made or suffered by me, that I have full right and power to  
 all, convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and  
 defend the same unto the said Roberts his heirs and assigns forever against the  
 lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me  
 but against none other. And I the said William Stevenson, my heirs  
 executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents  
 in the sum of Seven hundred dollars, to the said James Roberts his heirs and  
 assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further rights title  
 which I shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any  
 person or persons whomsoever.
