 dollars, to me in hand paid by Ward Mallory of Delavan State of Wisconsin the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these pres-
 ents do bargain sell and quit claim, unto the said Ward Mallory and to his heirs and assigns
 forever all my right title estate interest claim and demand in possession or expectancy of, in and
 to the following, described land, situated in Lawrence Kansas, to wit, Being, lot number
 one hundred and ninety seven (197) Indiana Street and lot number one hundred
 and twenty one (121) one New York Street, One hundred and sixty seven (167)
 one Rhode Island Street and two hundred and thirty six (236) on Indiana
 Street according to a map and survey of said town, made by A. D. Search, A. D. 1858.
 To have and to hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appur-
 tenances thereto belonging, unto the said Ward Mallory, his heirs and assigns forever.
 And I the said William H. Green for myself and my heirs, executors and administra-
 tors, do covenant with the said Ward Mallory his heirs and assigns that the said
 premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me, that I had full
 right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and
 will warrant and defend the same unto the said Ward Mallory his heirs and
 assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by
 through or under me, but against none other. And I the said William H.

 these presents, in the sum of one Thousand dollars, to the said Ward Mallory
 his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right
 or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by
