

Leiby of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim, unto the said Dr J. Leiby his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all right, title, interest claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situate, and lying in the City of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Sead A. D. 1854, to wit, Lot number one hundred and sixty five (165) Rhode Island street. And I John Speer aforesaid my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred dollars, to said Dr J. Leiby aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence, or from any person or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
