Leiby and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right title estate interest claim and demand, in possession and in expectancy, of, in and to the following described land, situated in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit, No thirty four Henwick Street To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said Dr J. Leiby his heirs and assigns forever, And I the said John Speer for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with Dr J. Leiby his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Dr J. Leiby his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by, through or under me but against none other, And I the said John Speer my heirs and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of three hundred dollars to the said Dr J. Leiby his heirs, executors and administrators to make and convey unto him or them all further right title which or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons by virtue of a bill to the Town Site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the general Land Office.
