This Indenture. Made this First day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine. between James M. Hendry of Lawrence, Douglas County Kansas Territory of the first part, and Hannah Christie of Franklin County, Territory of Kansas of the second part. Witnesseth That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and eighty (280) dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give grant, bargain, sell, release convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns forever, all the following described land, situated in City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas Territory, to wit: Lots 183 and 184 on Massachusetts St. lot No 185 Vermont St. lot No 179 Kentucky St. lot No 229 on Ohio St. Lots No 144 and 146 on New York St. and lot No 16 Pennsylvania St according to the survey of said City of Lawrence made by A. D. Seal, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, both in law and equity. This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred and eighty (280) dollars, according to the condition of a certain promissory note, this day executed and delivered by the said James M. Hendry, party of the first part to the said party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in payment, or any part thereof as above provided, then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of
