This Indenture made this Second day of June A.D. 1855 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John B. Wood William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Town and of Lawrence Kansas Territory, Parties of the first part, and Wilder Knight party of the second part. Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins, to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Wilder Knight of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quit claimed, and by these presents do convey, release and convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to the certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart, as surveyed by A. T. Seart, October, A.D. 1854, as follows:
